The following are the questions and answers regarding SRTA RFQ #48499-08-00006 Traffic and Revenue Consultant.

- 1. Are any of the following included in the 15 double-sided page count: tab dividers, covers, letters of reference?**

NO

- 2. Will a consultant/sub consultant be conflicted out of providing the Traffic and Revenue studies on GDOT RFQ (RFQ 484-071708 HOV to HOT conversion) if they are selected to provide SRTA Traffic and Revenue Studies on SRTA RFQ 48499-08-00006 (Traffic and Revenue Consultant)?**

Consultants/ sub consultants may do both.

- 3. The RFQ indicates the selection of a single consulting firm with an immediate proposed task order as indicated on page 3 of the RFQ. Is it the intent of SRTA to provide the selected consultant with all other traffic and revenue studies which may be required within the State, or does SRTA intend to retain multiple traffic & revenue consultants to perform other traffic and revenue studies?**

SRTA intends to retain a single consultant to perform multiple studies within the state.

- 4. Does SRTA anticipate the requirement of a comprehensive traffic and revenue study for the immediate proposed task order specified in the RFQ?**

- 5. What is the duration of the contract being awarded pursuant to this RFQ (#48499-08-00006)?**

The contract duration will be for 2 years. The SRTA will reserve the right to extend the contract for one additional year thereafter.

- 6. Your RFQ states that “The Offeror shall have in business for at least five consecutive (5) years.” Our firm, is a recognized traffic and revenue firm with operations in the United States and Internationally. Our parent company, located outside the United States, has been in business for 32 consecutive years. To better serve our clients in the United States we incorporated in early 2004 a US corporation, which is 4 years, 4 months of consecutively being in business. Could you please confirm that the 32 years of experience of our parent company can be counted for this requirement or, alternatively, that the 5 year requirement can be lowered to 4 years?**

Yes, the international parent company’s years of experience may be counted for this requirement.

- 7. Your RFQ states that “The Offeror must not be currently engaged in any active contractual agreement for similar services on any Public/Private Initiative projects in the State of Georgia.” We are currently under contract with GDOT to provide traffic and revenue services in support of their PPI projects. We have agreed with GDOT to work only with the Public side (GDOT/SRTA) on PPI projects in Georgia. Can you please confirm that this requirement does not apply to GDOT contracts?**

The requirement does not apply in this circumstance. Consultants doing work on the “Public Side” with GDOT will not be restricted.
