- Subsection 23.13.1 on page 12 of 15 of the ITB is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:**

23.13.1 The Bidder must have 3 years of experience of producing Transponders and Reader Subsystems for tolling applications in volumes of 1,000,000 Transponders per year or more for tolling applications; or, if Bidder is a reseller, their supplier must have 3 years of experience of producing Transponders and Reader Subsystems in volumes of 1,000,000 Transponders per year or more for tolling applications.

- Subsection 23.13.1 on page 6 of 10 of Appendix B – Technical Compliance Form of the ITB is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:**
