# Albany Transit System Multimodal Center

- Project Type: Facility (Transfer)
- Project Status: Environmental Assessment
- Estimated Completion: March 2019

- Summary:

Replaces an existing transfer facility, provides new features (arrival time information, covered passenger areas, computer lab), and makes room for 2 new routes. Facility will also house dispatch and administration.

# Athens-Clarke County Bus Replacement (Hybrid-Electric)

- Project Type: Bus Replacement (10 buses)
- Project Status: Ready for Purchase - Existing Contract
- Estimated Completion: June 2018
- Summary:

10 hybrid-electric buses and associated capital assets to support new technology. Buses would replace diesel buses that have reached their useful life.

# Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) Bus Stop Amenities

- Project Type: Other – Stop Amenities
- Project Status: Procurement Phase
- Estimated Completion: December 2018
- Summary:

MARTA and CCT to install approximately 10,000 consistently-designed-signs in Fulton, DeKalb and Cobb. \$2 million of the total \$9.7 million will be used for benches, shelters and sidewalk upgrades.

Purchase of 26 buses over a 5 year period.

# Cobb Community Transit (CCT) Route 10X Bus Expansion

- Project Type: Bus Expansion (12 buses)
- Project Status: Ready for Purchase - Existing Contract
- Estimated Completion: December 2017
- Summary:

12 new buses for a new route (“10X”) covering 26 miles, with limited stops (7) from Town Center to Midtown MARTA. Combines two existing local routes reducing the need for transfers and improving travel time.

# Cobb Community Transit (CCT) Cumberland Circulator Bus Expansion

- Project Type: Bus Expansion (6 buses)

6 new buses for a two-route circulator system serving major destinations in the Cumberland area (Home Depot Support Center, Sun Trust Park, Cobb Galleria, etc.). Frequencies of 15-30 minutes based on time of day and game day needs.

# Gwinnett County (GCT)

## Sugarloaf Park & Ride Upgrade

Project upgrades the existing Sugarloaf P&R lot to add an additional bus lane, traffic signal and adds/updates transit amenities (e.g., passenger pavilions, fare building) in addition to other minor improvements.

## Jonesboro Road P&R (Expansion)

New P&R lot at Jonesboro Road in Henry County which will have immediate access to the I-75 managed lane that is under construction. Location and operational plans under development.

# MARTA

## Audio-Visual Information System

- Project Type: Other - Technology
- Project Status: Preliminary Engineering
- Estimated Completion: December 2018

- Summary:

Upgrades the public address system and electronic information signs at MARTA's 38 rail stations. 95% of existing signs will be replaced, 330 new signs added. 3,990 speakers replaced, 590 added. Upgrades include bi-lingual and "synchronized" messaging, display of partner agency arrival data, etc.

# University of Georgia (UGA) Bus Replacement (Electric)

- Project Type: Bus Replacement (19 buses)
- Project Status: Procurement Phase
- Estimated Completion: June 2017
- Summary:

19 electric buses and associated auxiliary equipment. 12 would replace existing buses (among a fleet of 57) while seven may be used to expand service or to replace other buses near the end of useful life (10-11 years old).
