REMINDER: Add Your New Peach State Plate to Your Peach Pass Account



Got a new Georgia license plate? The State Road and Tollway Authority reminds you to add your Peach State plate to your Peach Pass accounts to avoid violations when using the I-85 Express Lanes or the all-electronic toll lanes on GA 400.

Peach Pass customers can update their vehicle license plate information online by accessing their accounts at www.PeachPass.com and clicking on the “Manage My Account” tab (*must have user id and password*).
