## REMINDER: New Peach State Plate and Motor Vehicle Tax Now in Effect



Got a new Georgia license plate? The State Road and Tollway Authority reminds you to add your Peach State plate to your Peach Pass accounts to avoid violations when using the I-85 Express Lanes or the all-electronic toll lanes on GA 400.

## One-time Tax to Replace Yearly “Birthday Tax” for New Vehicles

A new law (House Bill 386) enacted on January 1, 2013 officially ends the ad valorem tax, also known as the “birthday tax,” for vehicles purchased or titled in the state of Georgia on or after March 1, 2013.

The “birthday tax” will be replaced by a one-time tax called the Title Ad Valorem Tax (“TAVT”) based on the fair market value of the vehicle. Imposed at the time the vehicle is sold or titled, the TAVT rate will be 6.5% of the fair market value as identified by the Georgia Motor Vehicle Assessment Manual for the first year, according to the Georgia Department of Revenue.
